Opportunites in VET include:

- Certificate II, III and IV nationally recognised qualifications
- Pre-apprenticeships and paid School Based Traineeships, through which students can gain a qualification in an industry area of interest
- Courses through TAFE, MTAWA (Motor Trades Association) and CET (College of Electrical Training)

Certificate courses contribute points to the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE). Courses offered at Warwick Senior High School include:

- Certificate III in Business
- Certificate II in Community Services
- Certificate II in Construction Pathways
- Certificate II in Sport & Recreation
- Certificate II in Workplace Skills (formerly Certificate II in Business)

The Workplace Learning Program enables schools and industry to work together to provide opportunities for students to prepare for the workplace. Students have the opportunity to develop and demonstrate employability skills required for the world of work whilst helping them decide if a particular industry or job is right for them.


