

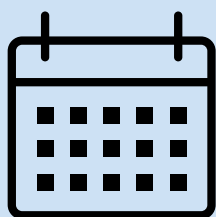

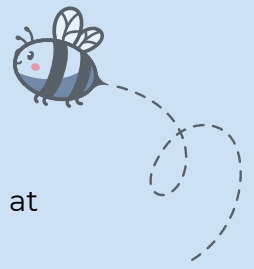
Throughout the year, staff capture photos of students at events, receiving awards, in the classroom and on excursions and we want to share them with you!

If your family is experiencing financial difficulties please contact MCS, Mrs Tayla Barber, on 9345 6430 to arrange a payment plan.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

Are you eligible for the [Secondary Assistance Scheme](#)?

The allowance consists of two components:

- \$300 Clothing Allowance paid directly to parent/guardian or the school.
- \$235 Educational Program Allowance paid directly to the school.

To be eligible, you must hold one of the following cards:

- Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card
- Centrelink Family Health Care Card
- Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card (blue card only)

Application is made by the parent/guardian for students enrolled in Years 7 to 12 studying a full time secondary course at a WA public school.

The parent/guardian must be the holder of a card that is valid sometime during the first term. Students must be listed on claimant's card (excluding some exceptions).

The only exception to this is when a student holds their own health card and has been declared independent by Centrelink (Living Away from Home) in which case, a letter of confirmation from Centrelink must accompany the application.

The concession card must not be expired when applying.

Application forms are available from the school front office.

Applications will close on 11 April 2025 (Last day of Term 1).

SCHOLARSHIP

Rotary Youth Exchange is offering a full scholarship for a WA secondary student who would like to spend a year living and going to school overseas in 2026, but whose family is not financially able to fund it.

Students need to be:

- outgoing, interested in other cultures and adventurous
- aged at least 15 (and finished at least year 10) and no older than 18.5 by January 2026 when the exchange would begin
- In good health, achieving to the best of their ability in school and demonstrating care for other.

WHAT'S PROVIDED

- the exchange fee (\$9,000) (covers airfares, visas, insurance, uniform, training etc)
- \$1,000 to help with clothing etc
- Full board with host families , school expenses (fees, uniforms etc) and a small monthly allowance
